Free Overdrive Audio Books!

There are over 2000 digital audio books available for free at UDPL's web site! Optimized for downloading, audio books can be played on any Windows or Mac hardware, from your computer, pocket pc, windows mp3 player or iPod! Many titles can be burned to a cd as well.

- Create wish lists of your favorites to download at your convenience!
- No late fees! Titles automatically check themselves back in after two weeks.
- Downloads are customizable depending on your connection speed. Parts can be downloaded all at once, or one at a time, for dial-up users.

What do you need?

- A Montgomery County public library card
- A computer (Win 98 SE or Mac v10.4.9 or newer) or a smartphone (Android, Blackberry, iPhone or Win Mobile)
- Internet access
- Overdrive Media Console and Windows Media Player 9 or newer (free

downloads)

- *Optional:* A Windows based mp3 player, that can support the bit rate of 32kbps and be able to play secure Windows Media files (.wma)
- *Optional:* A supported device such as an iPod, iPhone, or pocket pc
- *Optional:* A CD burner and burnable media.

How does it work?

Set up your computer

1. Go to <http://www.upperdublinlibrary.org> and click "Overdrive Audio Books & eBooks" under 24/7 resources.
2. Download and install the free Overdrive Media Console and Windows Media player software.
3. Upgrade your Windows Media Player license by going to the Overdrive Media Console program, Tools, and Windows Media Player Security Upgrade.

Check out a Book

1. Sign in to the Overdrive web site using your library card barcode.
2. Check out a book by clicking "Add to my Cart" & then "Proceed to Checkout"
3. Confirm your checkout and download the book. When prompted, open the book with Overdrive Media Console instead of

saving it to your hard drive.

4. Overdrive Media Console will automatically open. Follow the prompts and your download will begin!
5. If you need to download additional parts after your initial download, use the download button in the Overdrive Media Console, *not* the web site.
6. To play on your computer, press the green play symbol in the Overdrive Media Console.
7. To burn or transfer, select the buttons at the top of the Overdrive Media Console and follow the prompts.

Audio books can be checked out for two weeks. Files automatically expire themselves after two weeks, although you will have to delete the files from your computer and/or device manually. Sorry, there are no renewals or early check-in times available for audio books.

You may check out a combination of ten audio books & eBooks at a time.
